Subject: Important Meeting to Elect a Bargaining Committee

Your collective agreement will expire on December 31, 2019. As a result we are calling a special meeting on January 24, 2019 for all members working at the City of Vancouver, Vancouver Park Board, Ray-Cam Cooperative Centre, and Britannia Community Services Centre to elect a new bargaining committee. The four groups are linked under the labour code as one bargaining unit with the employer. As the employer pays for seven members we will elect seven people. We plan to do some preliminary ground work to prepare for the upcoming negotiations including meeting with the other civic unions and presidents from other CUPE locals in the lower mainland who represent municipal workers, as their contracts expire at the same time.
